

DECLARATION – Non CE Mark Required

Since 2006, Batteries Marketing and distribution has been regulated by: **EU Battery Directive 2006/66/EC.**

CSB VRLA battery series GP, GPL, HR, HRL, XHRL, HC, TPL, EVX, EVH, UPS, XTV, MSJ, MSV and MU batteries fulfill the definition and appliance of **Battery Directive 2006/66/EC**:

"..'battery or accumulator' means a source of electrical energy generated by direct conversion of chemical energy and consisting of one or more primary (non-rechargeable) batteries or secondary (rechargeable) cells, as listed in Annex I;"

Annex I:

BATTERIES AND ACCUMULATORS COVERED BY THE DIRECTIVE

- 1. Batteries and accumulators put on the market as from the date laid down in Article 11 (1) and containing:
- more than 25 mg mercury per cell, except alkaline manganese batteries;
- more than 0,025 % cadmium by weight;
- more than 0,4 % lead by weight.

EU Battery Directive 2006/66/EC is a Non CE Marking Directive, therefore,

CSB Battery declares that CE mark is not required for all CSB VRLA battery series indicated in this letter.
